

# Jerusalem

The score is for the piece "Jerusalem" by Mark Schubert, dedicated to Jay Griffiths. It is arranged for Flute, Vocal, Organ, and Flute. The music is in 3/4 time with a key signature of two sharps (F# and C#). The tempo is marked "Freely".
